

Non-Law Students Enrollment in Law Courses

In general, the law school does not permit non-law students to enroll in law courses. The following exceptions apply:

- 1) Honors College students may take part in the School of Law/Honors College partnership program
- 2) Students in the Joint JD/Masters in Accountancy or Tax programs may enroll in appropriate courses related to that program.
- 3) Students may enroll in a law course cross-listed in another department as permitted by the other department.
- 4) Graduate students in a degree program at the University of Mississippi may request permission to enroll in a law course. The Associate Dean for Academic Affairs may grant these requests after consultation with and agreement from the instructor for the course.
