



A few quick facts about the University of Alabama School of Law

- **Distinguished faculty** who have published with leading journals and university presses (including Oxford, Harvard, Princeton, Cambridge, Yale, and NYU)
- 3.91 **median undergraduate GPA** for the class of 2022 (2nd highest in the nation); 3.94 for the class of 2023
- 164 **median LSAT** for the classes of 2021, 2022, and 2023 (26th highest in the nation for the class of 2022)
- 98.5% **first-time bar passage rate** for the Alabama bar exam (2019); 93.7% first-time bar passage rate for all states in 2019
- 93.2% of 2019 graduates **employed or pursuing advanced degrees** within 10 months of graduation
- Graduates **located in all 50 states** and practicing law at leading law firms, in all branches of government, and at nationally recognized public-interest organizations
- No. 13 among all law schools in the nation for percentage of graduates securing **federal clerkships** over the last five years
