In accordance with Article VII of the Student Bar Association Constitution and Section 7.2 of the Law School Honor Code, and by a vote of 8-0, the Honor Council establishes the following judicial opinion, which is to be treated as judicial precedent:

All violations reported to the Honor Council Chair for review by the Honor Council must consist of a completed and signed form by the Claimant. This form can be found on the Law School's website and must be fully completed and submitted as an e-mail attachment.

For example, a Claimant may communicate with the Honor Council Chair, the Honor Council's Faculty Advisor, and/or the Associate Dean of Academic Affairs about a potential violation, but the report is not completed until the Claimant sends a completed report to the Honor Council Chair according to § 6.1 of the Honor Code.

Potential violations made by Claimants who do not provide the Honor Council Chair with a complete and signed form will not be submitted to the Investigation Committee for further review, nor will the potential violation be considered beyond the initial communication.

The Honor Council Chair is not responsible for submitting third-party violations after communication with students and/or faculty members.
