## **Application Instructions**

### **APPLICATION DEADLINE FOR FALL 2023 ENTERING JD STUDENTS: January 1, 2023**

#### **CHECKLIST FOR APPLICANTS:**

1. Complete The University of Mississippi School of Law application. Applications should be submitted through [LSAC.org](https://lsac.org).
2. Application Fee—A \$40 nonrefundable application fee should be submitted via credit card.
3. Personal Statement—The personal statement is important to your file. It is your opportunity to point out any noteworthy academic achievements, extracurricular activities, and business or civic experiences. The personal statement also enables you to demonstrate the ways in which you can contribute your talents and experiences to the law school. Successful applicants have also elaborated on meaningful personal and intellectual interests, challenges, and disadvantages met and overcome.
4. Academic Letters of Recommendation—A minimum of two academic letters of recommendation from professors who have taught you in class, or from professors who have direct experience with your academic ability and potential, are strongly preferred. If you have been out of school for a period of time, you may substitute letters from employers or others who are well-acquainted with your intellectual ability and academic ability. We strongly discourage recommendation letters from friends and family, and such letters do not substitute for academic letters of recommendation. Your letters of recommendation should be submitted through the LSAC Letter of Recommendation Service.
5. Résumé—We require you to submit your résumé. All gaps in your résumé must be explained.
6. Mississippi Residency Form IF establishing Mississippi residency
7. TOEFL (foreign applicants only, if applicable)
8. Register with Credential Assembly Service (CAS)—It is very important for applicants to become familiar with the LSAC website at [LSAC.org](https://lsac.org) so that you can monitor the activity of your application(s).
9. If you are applying to transfer/visit, DO NOT fill out this application. Please fill out the appropriate transfer/visitor application for the semester you are seeking to enroll.
